- 2 The application will be reviewed and if there are no Club members shown on the form you will be contacted by a member of the Committee and asked to meet with them and another Committee member at the water. The purpose of this is twofold: one to meet with the prospective new member and find out more about them, and two, to show you the reservoir including fishing tips.
- 3 The members will make a recommendation to the Committee whether to accept or reject the application. You will be notified of the outcome of this decision, which is final.
- 4 If your application is accepted but there are no vacancies then you will be notified of the position and added to the waiting list based strictly on the order of the date the application is accepted. You will be contacted when a place becomes available.
- 5 If your application is accepted and there is a vacancy then you will be contacted with a formal invitation to join upon payment of the Club bond, joining fee and appropriate membership fee.
- 6 The bond is a single payment due on joining the Club and is returnable in accordance with the Club's rules if membership ceases. The joining fee is a one off fee on joining the club and is not refundable. The membership fee is an annual payment due on 1st January each year but reductions will apply if the application is received after 1st June. The bond is £50, the joining fee is £50 and for the 2026 season the membership fee is £260.
- 7 On receipt of payment, you will be issued with a gate access key showing your membership number. You can then fish the water. If you have any questions or concerns then please contact Graham Hunt on 07912 781263.
